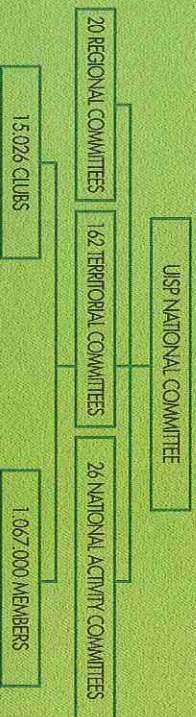

Organisational diagramme

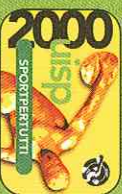

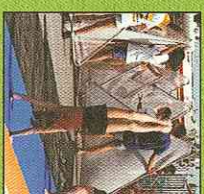
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Introducing Uisp: another idea of sport

Sport for All

Uisp's mission is not only to increase sporting activities but to ensure there is equal access to sport for all cultures in every level across society. We focus on social inclusion rather than the selection of the psychophysical attitudes aimed to the technical result. At the same time Sport for All represents a formidable opportunity of integration for marginalised people such as the elderly, disabled, and young people coming from areas at risk of social marginalization. In fact, besides sports traditional functions such as its ability to improve health, avert and channel aggression, promote fair play, and bring people together, sport can be used to integrate people of different backgrounds and encourage harmonious coexistence through creating a

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space where communication is a key focus between individuals and groups of people.

History

UISP was born in 1948 as a not for profit organization, promoted by democratic forces active in civil society and policy of the post-war Italy. Its goal was to promote sport in the working classes of the Italian population. At first the association was fully composed by volunteers, 20,000 in 1950.

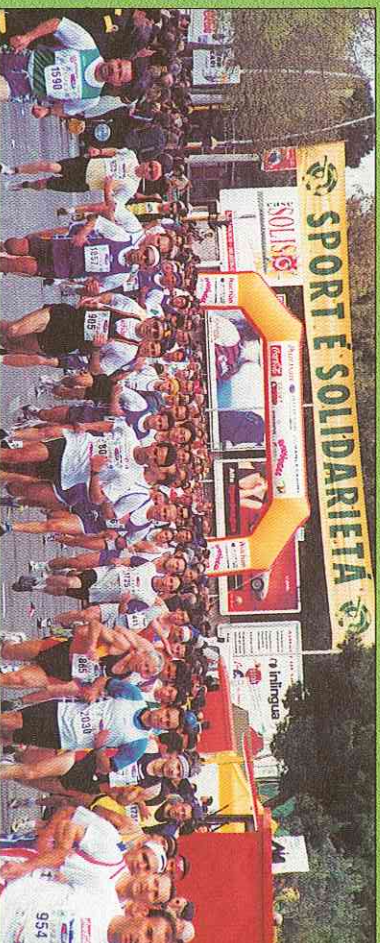
The activities of UISP developed and the certification as an Agency of Sports Promotion awarded by the Olympic Committee has been a fundamental step in UISP's capacity, particularly in terms of structural growth.

In the 50 years since UISP's inception the organisation has participated as protagonist to the cultural and political trends led by civil society, with permanent research on sport, its contents and methodologies.

In the eighties UISP improved the international relationship by expanding the exchanges with Sport for All associations of 31 Countries in the world, expanding its correspondence with National Olympic Committees.

In the nineties, in accordance with a large movement increasing in Europe, the "Sport for all" idea was introduced across the continent, intended as a primary right for all citizens, tackling every kind of exclusion, promoting well-being, improving quality of living, and education, free from the elitist idea of the top-level performance. Sport practice became culture, associationism, solidarity and civil engagement.

In this year UISP also created **Peace Games** an NGO for international co-operation, in order to place its experience and contacts at the disposal of disadvantaged populations in the world.



Events

Giocagain: day of sport and games for children organised every year in about 60 Italian cities with the goal of sensitise the public opinion on the problems of childhood in the world and to contribute to finance cooperation projects realized by Unicef and by Peace Games

Vivicità: not only a run but an important sport-mass event, in Italy and the world. Every year more than 70,000 citizens take part in it. A race "nobody excluded" in name of values like peace, solidarity, health, environment and eco-compatible solutions

Bicincittà: the possibility to use bicycle instead car in the center of city for a day. A non competitive cycle ride for environment and for the rights of cyclists

Diamoci una mossa: manifestation which wants to stimulate active life-styles and to promote the right to play for all children. Every year girls and boys play together outdoor, in the same day and in the squares of a lot of cities

Porte Aperte: projects towards the quality of life and the social insertion of young and adult convicts or under social control measures realised via sport practice

Summerbasket: one basket, and a three against three tournament in the outskirts for people of every age, with a final competition between the winners of every step

Mondiali Antirazzisti: a yearly sport manifestation against racism. Not only a football tournament between multiracial teams but a beautiful event to stay together in name of the racial integration and of the coexistence between different cultures
